Summer EECO Tour at The Ohio State University and Downtown Columbus

Explore two rivers and surrounding lands changed dramatically by dam removal:

The Olentangy River and the Ohio State's river corridor
The Scioto River and Columbus Metro Parks' redeveloped parkland

What we will do:

- Visit the Olentangy Wetlands Research Park and the Olentangy corridor to explore restoration projects, research, and learning opportunities on Ohio State's campus
- Enjoy a three-mile canoe tour of the site and projects along the 2013 Scioto River downtown Columbus dam removal, which added 33 acres of new greenspace for Columbus and Franklin County Metro Parks and Columbus Recreation and Parks

12:45 3-mile Scioto River canoe trip: overview of the Scioto dam removal, restoration, and land use (weather depending—rain plan will be communicated to the group if necessary)
2:45 Wrap up at Scioto Audubon Metro Park
3:00 Bus ride back to OSU Wetlands
